Manure and starter fertilizer additions resulted in significant cover/companion crop treatment effects on extractable P and K. Liquid dairy manure alone did not improve any soil quality indicators. Although soil quality benefits of cover crops and manure are typically attributed to additions of organic C, we found no significant treatment effects on SOM content.

For centuries, livestock manure has been a cost-effective fertilizer source for crops and increasing soil quality. Cover crops do the same thing and prevent nutrients from leaching.
