Before Jesus ascended into heaven he gave the Great Commission, telling his followers to go and make disciples of all nations. The stone was not rolled away from the tomb so Jesus could get out. He was able to walk through walls (John 20:19) in his resurrected body. The stone was rolled away so that everyone could see that he had risen.
