Twenty-seven British
 ships of the line led by
 Admiral Lord Nelson
 aboard HMS Victory
 defeated thirty-three
 French and Spanish
 ships of the line under
 French Admiral Pierre-
 Charles Villeneuve off
 the south-west coast of

Spain, just west of
 Cape Trafalgar. The
 Franco-Spanish fleet
 lost twenty-two ships,
 without a single British
 vessel being lost.

 110,000 individuals.
 So, if your ancestor

 chance that they
 served in the Battle of

October 1805, effectively ended the war at sea. Lord Nelson died at about 4.30pm. by which time he knew that he had achieved the overwhelming victory that he had planned so carefully. Nelson had left nothing to chance.

The muster roll for HMS Victory is held in the archives at the library here at the National Museum of the Royal

Navy. It names all the crew of the ship at the Battle of Trafalgar, each man on the list being awarded prize money for the enemy ships destroyed or captured during the battle. Besides Lord Nelson and Captain Hardy, there are 820 crew on this list.
