On June 5–6, 1834, following travel through Ohio, Indiana, and Illinois, picking up recruits along the way, Zion's Camp crossed the Mississippi River near the town of Louisiana, Missouri. On June 7 the troops arrived at a small branch of the Church known as Salt River, where they waited for 17 people from Pontiac,

Michigan, who were under the direction of Hyrum Smith, the Prophet's brother, and Lyman Wight.

Zion's Camp was an expedition that Joseph Smith put together in 1834 to follow instructions given to him in revelations that became Sections 101 and 103 in the Doctrine and Covenants. The Saints had been driven out of Jackson County, Missouri, and Joseph wondered how they would regain their lands.
