The digestive system is a myriad of organs functioning together to turn food into energy and basic nutrients to nourish the whole body. Food passes through a long tube on the inside of the body which is known as the alimentary canal or the gastriontestinal tract. Digestion begins in the mouth.

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The digestive system is an example of an organ system in which several organs work together to digest and absorb food. Digestion is a process in which relatively large, insoluble molecules in food (such as starch,

proteins) are broken down into smaller, soluble molecules that can be absorbed into the bloodstream and delivered to cells in the body. These small soluble molecules (such as glucose and amino acids) are used either to provide cells with energy (via respiration), or with materials ...

Process of the Digestive System. The overall digestive process involves a mixture of food and drink with the digestive juices. The food is then broken down into small molecules through chewing and the digestive juices and finishes in the small intestine. The

movement of the food down along the process is referred to as peristalsis.
