The law is there to protect children from abuse or exploitation, rather than to prosecute under-16s who participate in mutually consenting sexual activity.

Underage sexual activity should always be seen as a possible indicator of child sexual exploitation. Children aged under 13. The law says anyone under the age of 13 can never legally give consent.

Protecting children from emotional abuse | Action For Children

The UK's four nations - England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales - each have their own child protection system and laws to help protect children from abuse and neglect. Each nation has a framework of legislation, guidance and practice to identify children who are at risk of harm, take action to protect those children and prevent further abuse

occurring.

There is no clear legal definition of 'child abuse' but there are laws to protect children from harm. For example local authorities and certain other agencies or organisations that come into contact with children have a legal duty to protect them if they are: under 18, and, suffering, or are likely to suffer, significant harm.

What is child abuse? - Citizens Advice

In Scotland, legislation includes domestic abuse in the definition of child abuse (Section 24. Family Law (Scotland) Act 2006). The Domestic Abuse (Scotland)

Act 2018 also makes it a statutory aggravation for domestic abuse to involve or affect a child (this includes a child hearing, seeing or being present during an abusive incident).

specifically, the primary federal law is the Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA). CAPTA was first enacted in 1974, and has been reauthorized and amended many times since. CAPTA requires states to implement specified federal policies in exchange for federal funding for child abuse and neglect programs.

Whoever, having the actual charge of, or control over, a child, assaults, abandons, abuses, exposes or wilfully neglects the child or causes or procures the child to be assaulted, abandoned, abused, exposed or neglected in a manner likely to cause such child unnecessary mental or physical suffering, shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years or with fine of one lakh rupees or with both:

There are also legal rules about the evidence which can be used in court – this may mean that some cases of child abuse can't be prosecuted. Who can be charged with child abuse? Anyone aged ten or over can be charged with a

criminal offence associated with child abuse. However, it's is rare for young children to be prosecuted.

An introduction to child protection legislation in the UK

Some employers are under a duty to have a Child Protection Policy within their workplace which places a duty upon their employees to safeguard and promote the welfare of children; this includes reporting abuse to the relevant authorities. Bodies that are generally under this duty include Schools, colleges, health authorities and health trusts.

Child abuse

Child abuse is a particularly sensitive,

emotive and delicate issue, and is widely perceived as a heinous crime by the general public. Most forms of child abuse are a criminal offence but civil actions may be taken in negligence against local authorities and police entrusted with child protection.
